

Psalm 19:7-11

The sufficiency of Scripture is the subject matter of the second half of **Psalm 19.** Scripture is the means through which God reveals Himself and His will to His people. There is reward when we respond to His word and grief when we don't.

Whether we believe that Scripture is sufficient for us will be indicated by the regard that we have for it. The desirability and delight of God's word are put on display in **verse 10** where David described God's judgments as "more desirable than gold, than much fine gold" and "sweeter also than honey and the drippings of the honeycomb."

All of us make choices in life according to those things that hold value for us. Sometimes, those judgements are based on what only appears to be valuable, like the child who chooses the nickel over the dime considering only the size of the coin. But when our decision making is guided by the truth then our way is secure and His Word becomes priceless to us.
