Philippians 4:11-13

'I can do all things through him who strengthens me.'  
Philippians 4:13

It is one of the most quoted verses from the Bible. But people rarely quote the verses that precede it and put it into context:

'Not that I am speaking of being in need, for I have learned in whatever situation I am to be content. I know how to be brought low, and I know how to abound. In any and every circumstance, I have learned the secret of facing plenty and hunger, abundance and need. I can do all things through him who strengthens me.'
