



Isaiah 6:1-8

We are familiar with this passage because of the details of Isaiah's cleansing before God. But his vision of God served another end and that was to prepare him and equip Him for God's purposes.

A.W. Tozer said it best: "A low view of God is the cause of a hundred lesser evils." But a person with a "high view" of God "is relieved of ten thousand temporal problems."

When Isaiah saw God for who He was it was like someone had turned on a searchlight that illuminated every dark place in his heart. The result was confession that was both personal and corporate in nature. And this moment of redemption was the beginning of an impactful ministry.

A big vision of God produces humility in those who worship Him and results in availability. Though we may not have an *Isaiah 6* kind of moment we can say with the apostle Paul ***"Yet for this reason I found mercy, so that in me as the foremost, Jesus Christ might demonstrate His perfect patience as an example for those who would believe in Him for eternal life."***
